How to Start?

With Inspiration

The first thing I always do is look for inspiration.

This could be from Pinterest, a photo, a fabric, or even a piece of art.

Ask yourself:

- What colors are speaking to me?
- Do I want this space to feel warm or cool?
- Do I see more contrast or softness?





Sometimes I create a small mood board. Sometimes I just save a few images.

What matters is that you start noticing the color themes in the things you love.

I usually gather 3-5 images that give me the desired vibe, and then I move on to defining the colors.

Practical Aplication Tips



This is usually a neutral, like a soft white, beige, greige, taupe, or even black.

The base color is important because it holds the whole palette together.

It shows up in your walls, large furniture, or flooring, the big pieces that don't change often.



Once the base is locked in, it's time to add accent colors.
These are the shades that bring personality to your space.

You can use the 60-30-10 rule as a guide:

60% = base

30% = secondary color

10% = bold accent
